



# TROOP 69 - SUMMER CAMP 2011

## Ben Delatour Scout Ranch, Red Feather Lakes, Colorado

**WHERE:** The initial planning for our 2011 Summer Camp has been completed. We have chosen the Ben Delatour Scout Ranch located near Red Feather Lakes, Colorado, nestled in the foothills of the Rocky Mountains, next to the Roosevelt National Forest. This ranch offers over 30 merit badges to select from, handicrafts, shooting, trout fishing, conservation projects, horseback trail rides, whitewater rafting and much, much more...all at an elevation of 7,200 feet! Ben Delatour Scout Ranch provides 2-person platform tents, while family style meals will be served three times per day in the Camp Jeffery Dining Hall.

**WHEN:** We will be leaving for camp on July 8 and returning to Palatine on July 17. This time period will not interfere with the first semester of summer school and also allow the scouts to be home with their families for the 4th of July holiday.

**FEES:** The Ben Delatour Scout Ranch fee is \$230 per scout/\$100 per adult (payable in three installments) plus an estimated fee of \$245 to \$270 per scout/adult to cover travel/food expenses and at least one out trip. The total should fall between \$475 - \$500 per scout and \$375 - \$400 per adult. Spending money and merit badge/activity fees will be the individual scout's responsibility.

**INITIAL DEPOSIT:** Many of you have already expressed interest in your son(s) attending summer camp. We require a \$50 deposit from each scout/adult who will attend, no later than the Court of Honor on December 15, so that we may lock in our reservation. Please make your check out to Troop 69 and give it to either Mr. Radzik or Mr. Cramer by this date.
